## Admission to 3-Year LL.B. (Hons.)

Chanakya National Law University-Entrance Test (CNLU-ET), 2026

### General Instructions:

1. The CNLU-ET, 2026 shall be in OFFLINE (Pen-and-Paper) mode.
2. The applications have to be submitted in ONLINE mode only through the University website, i.e., [www.cnlu.ac.in](http://www.cnlu.ac.in)
3. The CNLU-ET, 2026 is scheduled to be held on **Sunday, 17<sup>th</sup> May, 2026** from **3:00 pm to 5:00 pm** (Subject to revision in case of necessity), the PWD/SAP candidates are eligible for an additional time of 40 minutes i.e. from 3:00 pm to 5:40 pm.
4. Information regarding the details of intake, reservation policy and the course offered along with the fee structure are available in the Information Brochure uploaded on the University website, i.e., [www.cnlu.ac.in](http://www.cnlu.ac.in)
5. The candidates are, therefore, advised to go through the rules & regulations and the fee structure of the 3-Year LL.B. (Hons.) course before filling in the application form.
6. Candidates are advised to visit CNLU website regularly for updates. The allotment of seats and the offer for admission under CNLU-ET, 2026, shall be provisional.
7. If more than one candidate secure equal marks in the CNLU-ET, 2026, the break of tie shall be done by the following procedure and order:
  - i. Higher marks in the component/section on General and Critical Reasoning in the CNLU-ET, 2026 exam;
  - ii. Higher in age;
  - iii. Computerised draw of lots.

8. The online enrolment for CNLU-ET 2026 will open on 13<sup>th</sup> April, 2026 and close on 11<sup>th</sup> May, 2026.
9. The application form, complete in all respects and after payment of requisite fee, must be finally submitted on or before 11<sup>th</sup> May, 2026 (11:59 pm.). The candidates shall fill and submit the application form well on time to avoid last minute hassles. The University shall in no case be responsible for any incomplete information or misinformation or inconvenience faced by the candidate in this regard.

**How to fill in online application:**

1. The candidates are first required to register themselves at the CNLU-ET 2026 portal by using personal mobile number and e-mail Id. Upon registration, an OTP will be sent to the registered mobile number for validation. Once the mobile number is validated, candidates can login using the registered mobile number and the password provided at the time of registration.
2. Please fill the application form carefully. The Name of the candidate and the parents shall be spelt correctly in the application as it appears in the Certificates/Mark sheets/Identity proof.
3. Please note that once the application is submitted and requisite fee is paid, the candidate cannot change the category.
4. Updates or corrections to application form will be not be entertained after final submission.
5. The candidates are required to read the instructions carefully and furnish correct and authentic information. In case the information furnished at any stage of the application, examination and admission process is found to be false or incorrect or if there is any discrepancy or mismatch between the information furnished by the candidate at the relevant section and the certificates/documents produced at the time of admission, the provisional admission offered to the candidate shall stand cancelled with immediate effect without assigning any further reason.

6. The Test Centre will be at Patna only.
7. In order to claim the benefit of reservation (EWS/BC/EBC/SC/ST), the relevant certificates issued by the competent authority of the Govt. of Bihar only must be uploaded; and the original certificate will be verified by the University at the time of admission.
8. In order to claim the benefit of reservation under PWD/SAP category, the relevant certificate issued by the competent authority must be uploaded; and the original certificate will be verified by the University at the time of admission.
9. If a candidate has filled-in more than one online application form, the **candidate's last online application form shall be considered**. In such case, the application fee for the previous application form shall not be refunded.
10. The result of the qualifying examination shall be submitted by the candidate at the time of admission, failing which the candidate shall be ineligible for admission to the course they may have applied for.
- 11. This course is a day-scholar programme; therefore, hostel facilities will not be available.**

#### **Documents to be uploaded during Online Application.**

1. Front facing passport size recent colour photograph with plain background.
2. Signature of the candidate.
3. Relevant category certificate issued by the competent authority of Bihar Govt. if applying under EWS/BC/EBC/SC/ST.
4. Relevant certificate issued by competent authority if applying under PWD / SAP category.

#### **NOTE:**

- The photograph of the candidate need not be attested while submitting the Online Application Form.
- All documents/certificates should be uploaded in pdf format only.

## Application Fee :

- Application fee can be paid **Online** only.

Application fee for SC*/ST*/PWD category candidates	Rs.2,500/- (Two Thousand Five Hundred only)
Application fee for Other Candidates	Rs.3,000/- (Three Thousand only)

\* Application fee of Rs. 2,500/- (Two Thousand Five Hundred) only for those candidates who have the SC/ST Caste Certificate issued from the competent authority of the Govt. of Bihar.

- The candidates themselves will have to bear the bank transaction charges, if any, for remitting the fee online. The actual bank transaction charges will be displayed in the payment gateway page after choosing the mode of payment.
- **Application Fee is non-refundable and non-adjustable.**
