Greetings from CNLU !

The candidates of CNLU-ET 2026 who have been provisionally selected for admission to the **3-Year LL.B. (Hons.) Course** and have deposited the prescribed University fee are hereby informed that they must appear in person with all original documents for verification of the scanned copies uploaded on the University Admission Portal, as per the following schedule.

Note: *Please ignore the Point No. 10 (Provisional admission after verification of all relevant documents on 30th June, 2026) of earlier Admission Calendar for the 3-Year LL.B. (Hons.) Course dated 12.04.2026, which was uploaded on the University admission portal and official website of the University.*

Further, the Orientation Programme for all newly admitted students of the 3-Year LL.B. (Hons.) Course shall be held on Thursday, 25th June, 2026 at 4:00 p.m. in Conference Hall No. 203 (Near Lift), First Floor, Administrative Building, CNLU, Patna.

The classes for the First Semester of the 3-Year LL.B. (Hons.) Course for the Academic Year 2026-27 shall commence from Wednesday, 1st July, 2026.

All candidates are advised to report at the venue well in time and bring all original documents required for verification. Failure to produce the requisite original documents may result in the cancellation of provisional admission.

Note :

- This course is a day-scholar programme; therefore, Hostel facilities will not be provided.**

- Provisional admission will be granted after thorough verification of the documents of the candidates. However, if any document is found not to be as per minimum educational eligibility criteria as mentioned in the Admission Notification or/and if any document is found to be forged/tampered/fake etc. at any point of time, the admission shall stand cancelled automatically.

REFUND POLICY

The last date of admission will be 31st July, 2026. If any admitted student in 3-Year LL.B. (Hons.) course for the Academic Year 2026-27 intends to withdraw from the said courses the following five-tier system for the refund of fees remitted by the students as per UGC Notification on Refund of Fees and Non-Retention of Original Certificates issued in October 2018 shall apply:

Percentage of Refund of Fees	Point of time when the notice of withdrawal of admission is received by Chanakya National Law University, Patna
100%	15 days or more before the formally notified last date of admission
90%	Less than 15 days before the formally notified last date of admission
80%	15 days or less after the formally notified last date of admission
50%	More than 15 days but 30 days or less after formally notified last date of admission
00%	More than 30 days after the last date of admission

Note : Refundable deposits shall be refunded in full.

NOTE :

1. The dress code is compulsory for the first two months of first semester, all the official functions and the Moot Courts (including Intra Moot Court Competitions) of the University. Hence, the students should get the dress ready which includes Black Trousers, White Shirt, Black Coat, Black Tie and Black Shoes, etc. On regular class days the students shall attend the classes with formal wear in conformity with the Bar Council of India Rules.
- The Medical facility on the campus is limited for minor ailments only. If student is suffering from any ailment / disease which warrant medical consultation on regular / frequent basis students and their parents need to make their own arrangements.
 - No vehicle is allowed inside the Gate No. 2 of the University campus. Students are discouraged to have four wheelers. The students shall park their two wheelers (outside the Gate No. 2) in the parking area of the University at their own risk. Failure to observe these Rules entails heavy penalty.

- The University upholds integrity, character, discipline and academic excellence to which every student must contribute. Students shall observe and adhere to the rules and regulations of the University. **Ragging and sexual harassment in any form is banned and is a punishable offence** and will entail immediate expulsion from the University. Use of any uncivilized or abusive or filthy language against a fellow student, teachers, non-teaching staff, outsourced personnel etc. and causing nuisance (including playing loud music, bursting firecrackers) will invite strict disciplinary action.
- The University has already constituted an Anti-ragging Squad and Anti-ragging Committee. The faculty would be doing their best to mould the career of every student in a manner that the University can justifiably be proud of. In this effort constant and continuing support of the parents is also solicited. Parents should accompany their wards at the time of joining of the University, so as to interact with the Vice-Chancellor, Registrar and Faculty.
- The University endeavours to inculcate, cultivate and develop in every student human dignity, fundamental moral values and high standards of discipline. The University is a non- smoking zone and consumption and possession of intoxicating liquors and psychotropic substances is punishable offence and is strictly prohibited (**Reference: The Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act, 2016**). Violation of any of these rules would be viewed as an act of indiscipline and may entail severe action which may lead to expulsion from the University.

Your joining of the University shall be deemed as voluntary consent to all the above conditions and other rules and regulations that University may make from time to time.
