



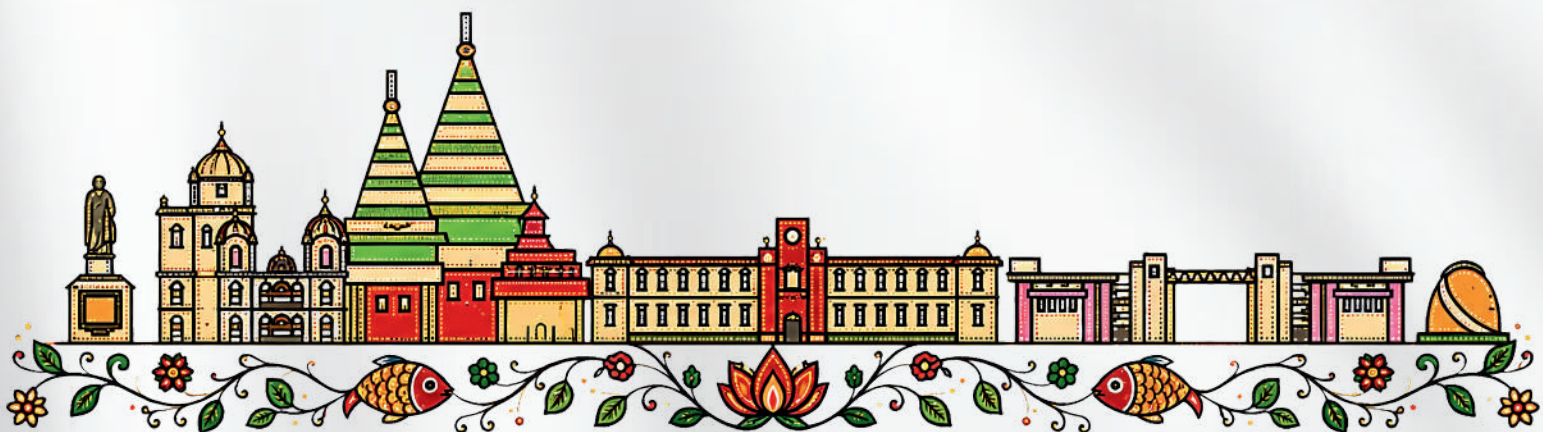

Academic and Debating Committee (“ADC”) at Chanakya National Law University, Patna, stands as one of the university’s oldest and most distinguished committees. Since its establishment, ADC has consistently cultivated a vibrant and competitive environment for debating, quizzing, literary pursuits, and academic excellence within the university. The committee also remains committed to ensuring high-quality student participation in national and international competitions, positioning CNLU as a formidable presence in the competitive circuit.

Demonstrating remarkable resilience during the COVID-19 pandemic, ADC adapted swiftly by transitioning to online platforms conducting regular debating society sessions and successfully organising landmark events including the 12th CNLU National Parliamentary Debate, the 1st National Quiz, and the 1st and 2nd CNLU British Parliamentary Debate during the academic year 2021–2022.

With the gradual return to physical engagements, the committee achieved significant milestones in its post-pandemic journey. The successful hosting of the 13th CNLU National Parliamentary Debate in September 2022 marked a triumphant return to in-person competitive debating. This momentum was sustained with the seamless execution of the 14th CNLU National Parliamentary Debate in September 2023, the 15th CNLU National Parliamentary Debate in 2024, and the 16th CNLU National Parliamentary Debate in 2025 each edition further cementing ADC’s reputation for meticulous organisation and academic rigour. To date, ADC has conducted **sixteen successful editions** of the CNLU National Parliamentary Debate Competition, making it one of the most consistent and celebrated inter-university debating traditions in the country.

Beyond competitive debating, ADC launched **PERSPECT: An ADC Dialogue** a distinguished lecture and dialogue series designed to foster informed discourse on pressing legal, social, and policy issues. PERSPECT brings together eminent legal practitioners, academics, policymakers, and student voices to engage in structured, thought-provoking conversations that transcend the conventional classroom. The series reflects ADC’s broader vision of nurturing not merely skilled debaters, but intellectually engaged and socially conscious legal professionals.

Building upon this legacy of excellence, the committee is now poised to host the **17th CNLU National Parliamentary Debate in 2026**, continuing its proud tradition of advancing debating culture and academic inquiry at the national level.





About

Asian Parliamentary Debating

A **Asian Parliamentary Debating (APD)** is the premier format of the tournament, challenging participants to demonstrate critical thinking, persuasive advocacy, and strategic argumentation. The competition progresses through the **Preliminary Rounds**, followed by the **outrounds**, with teams debating a diverse range of contemporary and intellectually demanding motions.

In each round, teams receive three motions and are allotted 30 minutes of preparation time, including **5 minutes for motion ranking** and **25 minutes for case preparation**. To preserve fairness and reward intellectual agility, the **use of the internet and other online resources is strictly prohibited** during preparation.

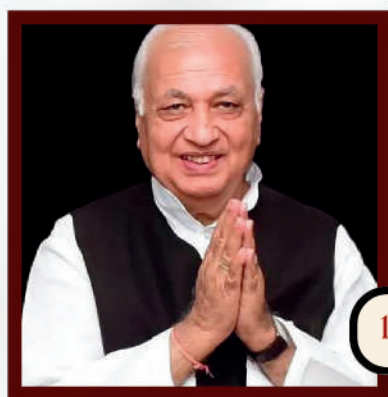

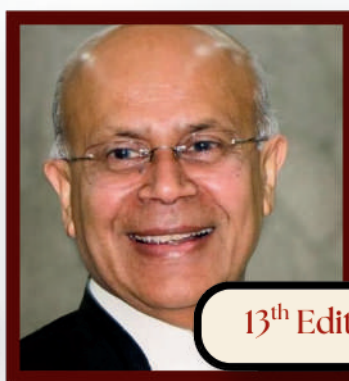

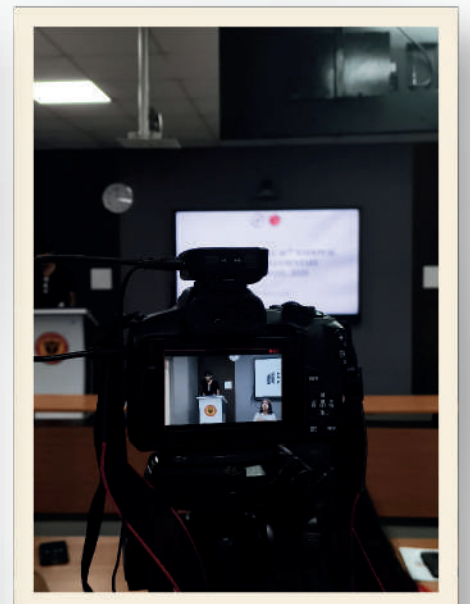
